SERVICES AND PROGRAMS

Our programs are designed to serve the most vulnerable populations in South Jersey in order to create stabilization and self-sufficiency for individuals, families and communities. This is our duty and responsibility. Please visit our website to learn more about all of our programs and services.

HOUSING STABILIZATION/HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION – Assisting with rent/ utilities,* furniture, housewares, and basic needs that reduce monthly expenses.

ADOPTION SERVICES – Facilitating search and reunification for adoptees and birth parents.

IMMIGRATION, REFUGEE, AND MIGRANT SERVICES - Assisting newcomers to access resources, navigate legal requirements, and integrate into the community through our English Learning Center.

PRISON MINISTRY - Offering pastoral and sacramental ministry to the incarcerated.

ADDICTION HEALING SERVICES - Meeting the challenges of addiction through education, awareness, and supportive services for families.

VETERAN SERVICES – Providing housing stabilization to at-risk and homeless veterans through the Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) Program grant. Call 856-340-9242 for more information.

SUPPORTIVE ASSISTANCE FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES (SAIF) PROGRAM – Helping welfare recipients achieve self-sufficiency.
